

Students of primary up to 19 years of age battled it out for Individual, team and school awards in 6 weeks of competition. Round 1 was held at Carrick Park Pacing club and it culminated this week at Trevallyn reserve with other venues including Heritage Forest, Scotch Oakburn Park, Hagley Farm Primary school and Grindelwald lake.

Each week we had in excess of 190 students from 21 primary and 8 secondary schools in age groups from under 9 to under 20.

This year's winning school in the primary competition trialling a new scoring algorithm was Scotch Oakburn College on 855 points followed by Sacred Heart School on 844 points, Hagley Farm Primary on 771 points then Invermay Primary on 615 points.

The senior competition was won by Launceston Church Grammar school (478 points) with Scotch Oakburn Senior school (467 points) 2nd, St Patrick's College (462 points) 3rd with Riverside High 4th on 356 points.

The Primary teams are made up of 5 students across any primary age group. The winning teams were, First Riverside Primary A (Thomas Death, Sophie Brewster, Chloe Harper, Layla Brewster and Hayden Brewster) followed by Sacred Heart A (Abbey Berlese, Campbell Spencer, Samuel Lindsay, Xavier Davie and Eliza Davie) and 3rd Norwood Primary A (Arden Eccles, Zoe Parkinson, Ava Eccles, Bradley Wicks and Riley Howard).
